

**Warranty.**  
**Aquamatic Vinyl Pool Cover Systems.**

Thank you for purchasing our Aquamatic Hydramatic automated pool cover system,  
**“The standard in automatic pool covers”.**

This warranty is limited to the first retail purchaser and is not transferable. The liability of the SSL Group shall not exceed the repair or replacement of defective parts and does not include any cost for labour to remove or reinstall the defective parts, transportation to or from the factory and any other material required to make the repair.

**Warranty.**

The cover system comes with a 2 year warranty on the mechanism and a four year warranty on the vinyl cover, being 2 years unlimited and 2 years pro-rata.

This warranty does not cover failure or malfunctions resulting from the following:-

- 1) Failure to properly install and maintain in accordance with our published installation instructions.
- 2) The workmanship of any unauthorized installer of the product.
- 3) Abuse, alterations, negligence or acts of God.
- 4) Use of non-factory parts and accessories.
- 5) Chemical damage or discolouration resulting from incorrect water balance issues.
- 6) Wear and tear to ropes, sliders, guides and fabric edges (webbing) are not covered by the warranty, as these items are consumables and are considered as wearing parts.

**Limitation of Liability.**

This is the only warranty given by the SSL Group, and is valid in New Zealand only. No one is authorized to make warranties on the SSL Group's behalf. This warranty is in lieu of all other warranties expressed or implied, including but not limited to any implied warranties or fitness for a particular purpose and merchantability. The SSL Group expressly disclaims and excludes any liability for consequential, incidental, indirect or punitive damages for breach of any expressed or implied warranty.
